Theme "Winter Wonderland goes to a wedding"
Queensland's Best Doll, Bear and Collectables Show
Competition Entry Form

Winter Wonderland is again pleased to offer A SPECIAL COMPETITION for 2012. As time and space dictate a restricted programme, our competition will focus on your choice of Reproduction Dolls, Original Dolls and Bears and we are reintroducing trophies for entries that best depict our theme "Winter Wonderland goes to a wedding".

Judging will be based on a points system and a written critique will be supplied. Small dolls will not be disadvantaged as each entry is assessed on its own merit and degree of difficulty will be considered.

90 – 100 points	Blue ribbon
80 – 89 points	Red ribbon
70 – 79 points	Gold ribbon

ROSETTES will be awarded to the highest blue ribbon point scorers in each section.

TROPHY WINNERS will be selected from Rosette winners.

CLASSES

Novice:- A person who has been making dolls or bears for under two years and has not won more than two major awards in any previous competitions at any doll show.

Non-Professional:- A person who does not teach or sell dolls or bears commercially and is not a multi-award winner in this class.

Professional:- A person who has taught doll or bear making for a fee and/or sells dolls/bears commercially and can be a multi award winner.

Open:- No restrictions (all classes)

RULES For 2012

- No restrictions as to when the doll or bear was made BUT must not be a major award winner in this or other shows (ie. Best in Show or Trophy Winners)
- Dolls and Bears may have been made in a workshop provided 'hands-on' work was by entrant.
- The costume need not have been made by the entrant BUT bonus points cannot be earned. (see below: Special Notes for Judges.)
- All entries must be on a stand and firmly secured. EXCEPTION: Babies can be presented laying on an attached pillow and Bears can sit unaided, if stable.
- All accessories to be securely attached to the doll or bear, BUT limit their size.
- All porcelain doll heads must be incised in greenware with makers name/mark and date and covered with opaque tape for judging; but shown to receiving steward as dolls not incised will be disqualified.
- Antique Reproduction Dolls will be judged on their authenticity i.e. painted and assembled as the original. No entry over 26cms to have a porcelain or eathernware body. Latex, papier-mache, wooden, composition and cloth bodies are accepted where authentic.
- Modern Reproduction Dolls will be judged on overall appearance and how well they are painted and assembled. They will be accepted on the appropriate authentic body.

- **LABELS:** May be attached to your entry if required (card 2.5 x 2.5cm)
- **DOLLS:** Identify if original, antique or modern reproduction. (State manufacturers mark if applicable.) Include 'Notes for Judges' and a photocopy of painting reference to assist with judging.
- **BEARS:** Identify if ORIGINAL or COMMERCIAL pattern used. (N.B. Variations of a commercial pattern must be entered into commercial category, not original.)

SPECIAL NOTES FOR JUDGES: Please state if: sleep eyes, handmade wig, shoes, clothing, embroidery etc. IS THE WORK OF THE ENTRANT so bonus points can be earned.

5 Bonus points can be earned at the judges discretion.

JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL

SECTION 1: REPRODUCTION DOLLS

Antique Dolls made before 1930 and Modern Artist Dolls made after 1930.

CLASSES: Non-Professional, Professional.

CATEGORY: A Free choice – Any Reproduction German Antique doll

B Free choice – Any Reproduction French Antique doll

C Free choice – Any Reproduction Modern Artist doll

CLASS: Open

CATEGORY: D Free choice – Any Reproduction Doll made by a Senior doll maker. (A person over 60 who does not teach dolls or sell dolls commercially)

AWARDS: A Rosette will be awarded to best in each class of each category.

A Trophy will be awarded to the best entry in each class.

SECTION 2 - NOVICE

CLASS: Novice

CATEGORY: E Free choice – Any Doll (Reproduction, Original or Reborn), any Bear or Furry Friend

AWARDS: A Rosette will be awarded to best in each class of each category.

A Trophy will be awarded to the best entry in this class.

SECTION 3 - ORIGINAL DOLLS

Dolls must be sculpted by entrant. Evidence of the entrant having made the head should be available on request. If the doll is a portrait, then a photograph of the subject must accompany the entry.

CLASSES: Non-Professional and Professional.

CATEGORY A All original with porcelain head, arms, legs and body (if applicable).

B Porcelain head - reproduction body and/or arms and legs.

C Any other medium – vinyl, wood, fimo, papier-mache, felt, plaster etc.

AWARDS: A Rosette will be awarded to best in each class of each category.

A trophy - will be awarded to best doll in each class.

SECTION 3 – REBORN

CLASSES: Non-Professional, Professional.

Category A - NOT Original

Please note: Original Reborn must be entered in Section 2, Category C.

AWARDS: A Rosette will be awarded to best in each class of each category.

Trophy - will be awarded to best doll in each class.

SECTION 4 – BEARS

CLASSES: Non-Professional, Professional.

Category A - Original Bear, must be made from your own designed pattern.

B - Original Furry Friend, must be made from your own designed pattern

C - Bear - Commercial Pattern. This includes any variations on a commercial pattern.

AWARDS: A Rosette will be awarded to best in each class of each category.

A trophy - will be awarded to best entry in each class.

SECTION 5 – GROUP SECTION

Studio or Group Entry—put together by members of a studio or a group ie. a diorama that gives a snapshot of a story in the Theme of the Show: “Winter Wonderland goes to a Wedding”. Please ensure that all items are secured onto a base or platform which allows for easy transport. The entire display must be no bigger than 5ft by 3ft. Studios must provide a list of students names with matching entry description. This should be suitable for display through-out the show.

Trophy awarded to Best of Section.

ADDITIONAL AWARDS

BEST OF SHOW AWARD - The spirit of this award is to encourage excellence in the craft. This award can be won multiple times, in recognition of outstanding quality. Entries will also be eligible for other awards, including the Helen Knell Memorial Award.

A trophy and cash prize of \$100 will be awarded to the winner

HELEN KNELL MEMORIAL AWARD - This award carries a cash prize of \$100 along with the prestigious Helen Knell Memorial trophy, and can be won only once.

Every rosette winner is eligible and a panel of judges will select the winning entry. Sponsored by John Knell and Kerry and Elizabeth Radford.

IRENE GREENFIELD PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD - All entries are eligible for the Irene Greenfield Trophy, as this is decided by public vote.

THEME AWARD - A **special award** will be presented to

Doll which best represents Theme **and** Bear or Furry friend which best represents Theme. This year's theme is "**Winter Wonderland goes to a Wedding**".

These awards consist of a special trophy. This is the only trophy that is selected by judges from all entries, and entries do not have to be rosette winners to be eligible.

TEACHER AWARD - This award will be presented to the teacher with the highest number of competition entries from their students. The award will consist of a special trophy and something for all at the studio to enjoy. So make sure you enter your teachers' details on your entry form.

ENCOURAGEMENT AWARD – Consists of a special trophy. This award presented at the judges discretion to acknowledge work of high merit.
